**For your information the College requires postgraduate students whose first language is not English to have one of the following:**

- **IELTS:** A score of 7.0 in all 4 sub-tests in the British Council IELTS.
- **TOEFL (Paper based):** An overall score of 600 for the paper based TOEFL, with a minimum score of 5 in the TWE (Test of Written English)
- **TOEFL (Computerised):** An overall score of 250 for the computer based TOEFL, with a minimum score of 5 in the essay
- **TOEFL (Internet):** An overall score of 100 in the internet based TOEFL
- **PLAB:** A pass in the Professional Language Assessment Board (PLAB) examination.

Exemption from this requirement is at the discretion of the programme organisers.

**STUDENTS SHOULD HAVE TAKEN EITHER THE TOEFL OR THE IELTS NO MORE THAN THREE YEARS BEFORE THE PROPOSED DATE OF ENTRY TO THE COLLEGE.**
